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## Spaces speak to children, inviting them to:



When designing a space, consider:

- Dividers: creating cul-de-sacs, pathways, and zones
- Child's eye view. Tip: sit on the floor
- Function and purpose: where do children store their stuff, where do teachers work and rest, where will parents sit?
- Quality of life: good ventilation, efficient heating, warm lighting, noise reduction, sufficient wash basins

Purposefully designed indoor spaces provide opportunities to engage in all kinds of activities and experiences.

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
